Founded in 1983, the European Materials Research Society (E-MRS) now has more than 3,000 members from industry, government, academia and research laboratories, who meet regularly to debate recent technological developments of functional materials. The E-MRS differs from many single-discipline professional societies by encouraging scientists, engineers and research managers to exchange information on an interdisciplinary platform, and by recognizing professional and technical excellence by promoting awards for achievement from student to senior scientist level.

As an adhering body of the International Union of Materials Research Societies (IUMRS), the E-MRS enjoys and benefits from very close relationships with other Materials Research organizations elsewhere in Europe and around the world.

Each year, E-MRS organizes, co-organizes, sponsors or co-sponsors numerous scientific events and meetings. The major society conference, the E-MRS Spring Meeting, is organized every year in May or June in Strasbourg, France, and offers on average 18 topical symposia. It is widely recognized as being of the highest international significance and is the greatest of its kind in Europe with about 2,000 attendees every year.

Each symposium publishes its own proceedings that document the latest experimental and theoretical understanding of material growth and properties, the exploitation of new advanced processes, and the development of electronic devices that can benefit best from the outstanding physical properties of functional materials.

2. ARRANGEMENT OF EXHIBITS

E-MRS reserves the right to determine final placement of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors agree to arrange their exhibits so as not to obstruct the general view of nor hide other exhibits. The booth decoration must be realized with non-flammable or fireproofing materials. Exhibitors must use extreme caution when operating equipment which could cause eye damage, emit excessive radiation or in any way harm visitors in the exhibit area.

3. INSTALLATION AND DISMANTLING

One half day for setting-up the booth, **Monday June 7 from 14:00 to 18:00**. The arrangement of the booths have to be imperatively finished at this time, due to the constraints of the regular control done by the Safety Department of the Congress Center. The storage of the empty boxes has to be planned with the Congress Center.

All transportation costs, and any other costs related to exhibit setup not explicitly offered above by E-MRS, are to be paid by the Exhibitor.

Dismantling the booth: **Thursday June 10, starting 16:00**. Exhibitors are bound to deliver their booth in its initial state. Eventual repair costs will be invoiced to the exhibiting company.

4. MAINTENANCE OF EXHIBITS

The cleaning of the exhibition is included in the fees. Moreover, the guarding will be done by the employees of the Congress Center at no charge.

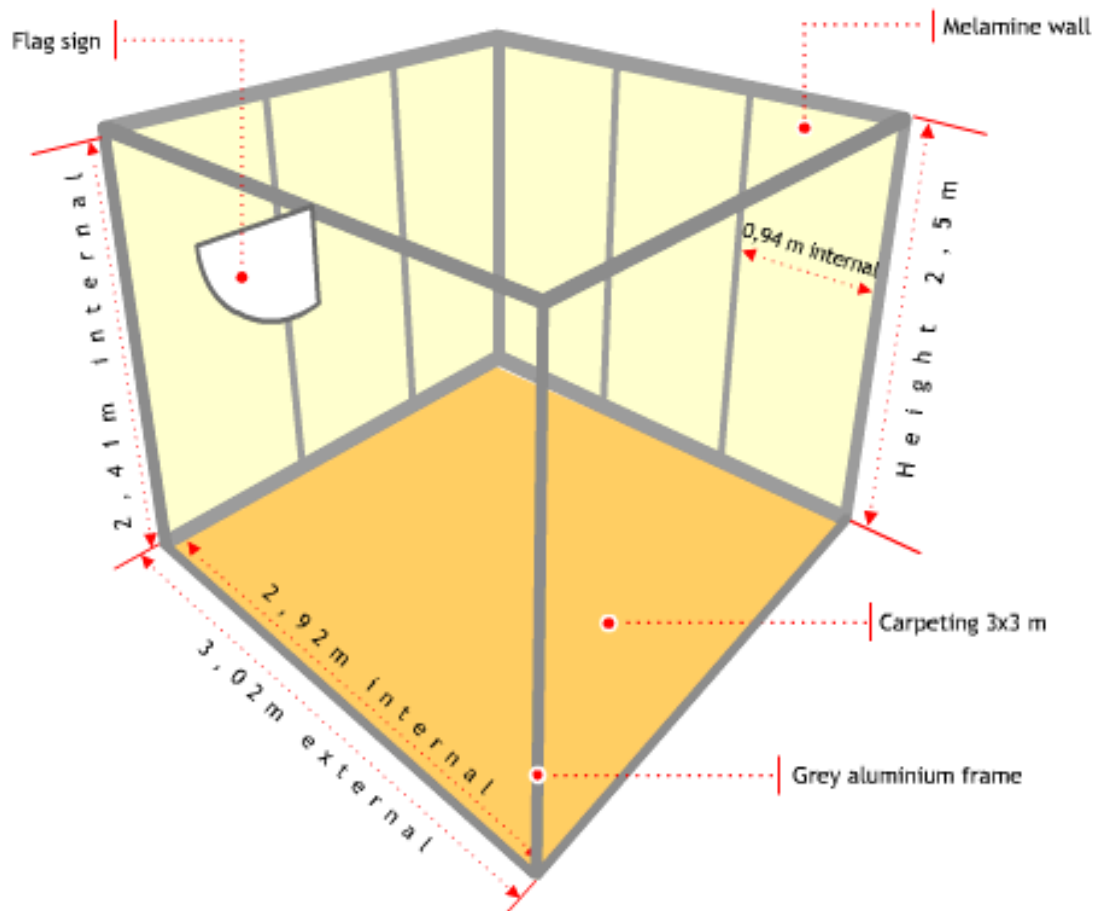
6. CANCELLATIONS

In case of cancellation, 70% of the booth rental will be refunded.

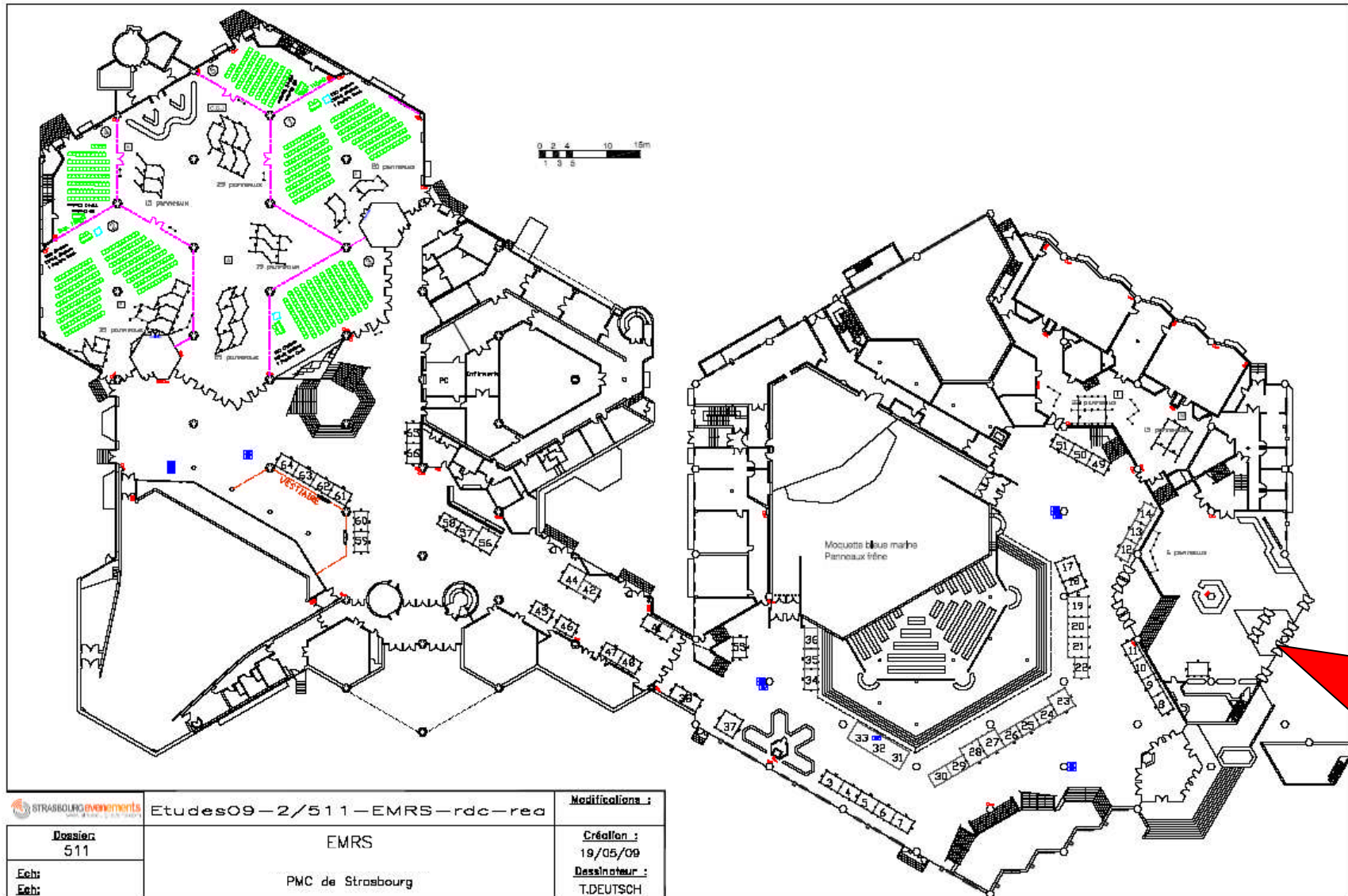
7. INSURANCE

10. TRAVEL INFORMATION

AIR:

From Strasbourg/Entzheim Airport has regular flights to European cities. Direct train connexion from the airport to the Central Railway station, approx. 20 min. Return by train from the same station.

From Frankfurt Airport (Germany) direct Lufthansa buses to Strasbourg or ICE fast train within the airport to Offenburg and than local train to Strasbourg.

From Paris/Roissy Charles de Gaulle: within the airport direct fast trains TGV to Strasbourg (2:25 hours) or Air France flights.

From EuroAirport Basel/Mulhouse/Freiburg airport: bus to Basel station then train (1:25 hour)

TRAIN:

Rail Europe allows you to book all types of European rail passes and tickets online. Eurail passes, Euro passes, Single country passes, Point to Point tickets, Rail 'n Drive passes, Night trains, Special trains, High Speed trains, Eurostar, etc. Online train schedules are also available: www.raileurope.com

ROAD:

Highways connected to the French as well as the German networks.

The French freeway network to the west and to the north, consisting of the A4, A34, A31 and A32 freeways, permits easy access of Strasbourg from Paris, Amsterdam, Brussels, Luxembourg et Bonn via Metz and Sarrebruck. The south, the axis Strasbourg-Mulhouse and the A36 intersection of the A6 freeway of Beaune, opens routes in direction of Italy and Spain. The German freeway network permits access to Hamburg, Frankfurt, Basel, Geneva and Milan and is less than 15 minutes from Strasbourg via Kehl. Keep some change with you as some motorways require toll fees to be paid as you travel.

Parking at the Congress Center

- Public parking (500 car spaces)
- E-MRS Conference Participants parking: when arriving to the public parking, take the small street behind the Hotel Holiday Inn, close to a traffic light enter on the left side the yard.

TRAVEL WITHIN THE CITY

Use the Tram grid. If you are travelling by car you can leave your car at a Relay-Tram parking lots offer parking next to a tram station and access the city center within a few minutes. The Relay-Tram Parking Lots Set up along the tram lines, the Relay-Tram parking lots (P+R) offer the possibility to park your vehicle close to a tram station and travel downtown without worry of traffic or parking. To get to Palais de la Musique et des Congrès de Strasbourg by tram

Tram Line B (towards Hoenheim Gare) or Line E (towards Robertsau) and get off at either Tram Stop Lycée Kléber, which is within walking distance and just before the Palais de la Musique, or Tram Stop Wacken, which is just after the Palais de la Musique et des Congrès.

Taxi

The Taxicabs are present at the airport until about 23.00 (arrival of the last flight).
